They could know more about how Hai Nan was developed into its Provincial status and a planned free trade zone in the country. • In culture, students were able to understand the lifestyle and traditions of the <i>Li</i> and <i>Miao</i> ethnic group from the visit to the ethnic village, guided by a local <i>Li</i> villager. Students also visited Leiqiong Geopark, a UNESCO Global Geopark, to see how the natural landscape was preserved in Hai Nan. • The planning and development of Hai Nan served as a good example for teachers in the topic of Modern China. The visit to the Permanent Venue of the Boao Forum for Asia could also offer extra resources to the teaching in the regional cooperation under economic globalization.
