

Preface

In order to broaden students' horizons and learning experiences and pursue greater mutual understanding through exchanges between our students and overseas students, our school arranged a 2-week cultural and educational programme to Canada for our students from 19th July to 1st August 2017. Ten secondary one to three students were selected to join the study tour with two accompanying teachers.

After a 12-hour long-haul flight, we were welcomed by a college representative of Vancouver International College (VIC) at the airport. Despite experiencing serious jet lag, students were very concentrate during the short briefing on the city's transportation and homestay information. We then sent students to the homestay families one by one. When the coach bus arrived at their homestays, students were all very amazed by the huge living space, accommodations and environment there.

During weekdays in these 2 weeks, students had graded English lessons with other teenagers from countries around the world in the mornings. After the lessons, students and teachers gathered together and enjoyed packed lunch prepared by their homestays. On weekday afternoons and on Saturdays, we did various local sightseeing activities like visiting the University of British Columbia (UBC), iconic spots of the town such as Gastown, Canada Place and Olympic Stadium. We had bicycle riding at Stanley Park to enjoy the leisure living style there. We also visited the Granville Island for open market and domestic produces, the Capilano Suspension Bridge for the forest, the Victoria B.C. for a unique blend of old world charm and new world experience and took a tour to the Whistler Mountain for nature beauty and Winter Olympic Game Village.

In the trip, I were happy to see another side and growth of my students. They showed us their strengths and advancement in self-management, as well as problem solving and inter-personal skills. They took care of each other, being understanding, co-operate and independent throughout. Thank you very much for all my beloved students and hope that all these precisious moments will stay in their hearts here and after.



Reflections from teachers

Vancouver Study Tour Mr. Chan Hon Shing, Joe

Our Canada study tour took place from 19th July to 31st July, 2017. We were ready to start off our journey to Canada. On the first day, we took part in the outdoor activity organized by Vancouver International College. Our students have had good performances and won some awards in the competition.

On Friday, we visited the Gas Town steam clock. According to the tour guide's introduction, Raymond Saunders built the first steam clock in 1977 at the corner of Cambia and Water Streets in Vancouver.

On Sunday, I went to Quarry Rock for hiking with Devon, Allie and Nate (my home-stay family) in the morning. We had great fun at Quarry Rock and there was a beautiful scenery. I really enjoy the countryside in Canada.





As a teacher of Chinese History, I think one of the most significant lessons for the entire Canada study tour was our visit to Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden. We seemed to have returned to the 15th-century China and visited the home of a scholar's family. Scholars in the Ming Dynasty were the elite of their time and they served as highly educated officials in the Imperial Chinese government. The Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden is the first of its kind built outside of China. Fifty-three master craftsmen came from China with 950 crates of materials and constructed the Garden using the traditional methods. The Garden Park was built with no glue, screws, or electrical tools used! The result is this enchanting space filled with the perfect balance of yin and yang (陰陽).

To conclude, we have had a wonderful time with our students during the local visit

activities. We did sightseeings in Canada at Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden and visited the Gas Town steam clock. Hopefully, we will have the opportunity to organize more cultural exchange study tours for our beloved students in the coming future.




