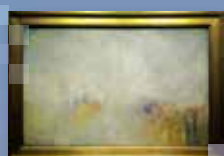

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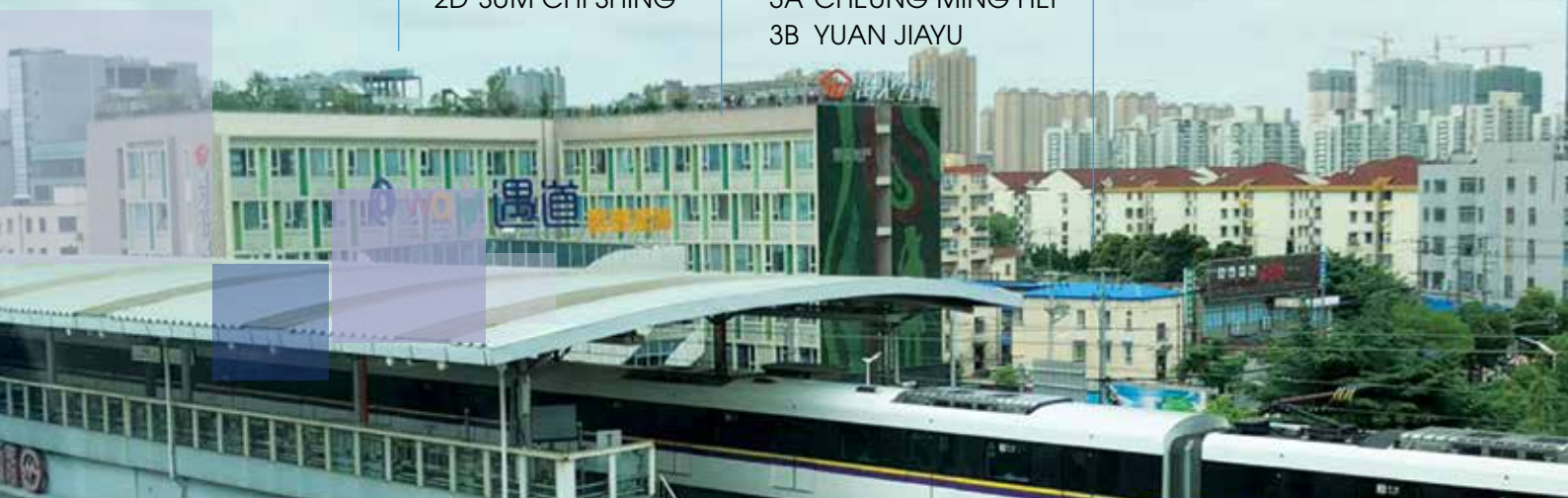

Sharing from teachers

Mr. Wong Tung Ming

The Technology Study Tour to Shanghai was held between 30th June and 4th July, 2018 with a big group of 15 students and 3 teachers. It was an unforgettable and wonderful trip. On the first day, the whole group visited the Shanghai Science and Technology Museum. There were many different exhibitions in the museum, such as the spider and the human structure, the biochemistry and electronics technology, which raised their interest in science and technology. After that, they went sightseeing around the CBD financial business district and the periphery of the Oriental Pearl Tower. The Oriental Pearl Tower is one of the most famous landmarks in Shanghai with more than 200 TV stations for all the viewers in China. Students were impressed by the number of TV channels that they could choose.

On the second day, they went to the Shanghai Urban Planning Museum and the Shanghai Museum, which introduces the direction of development and social economy of Shanghai city in recent years. In addition, many cultural relics were displayed in the Shanghai Museum, including the ancient bronze ware, currency and sculpture. Within these two decades, Shanghai has rapidly developed rapidly as one of the most economically developed cities in China.

On the third day, it was an honor to visit the Fudan University, which is the one of the top three universities in China. Apart from its ranking, they were also impressed by its historical exhibition hall. The museum staff not only introduced its awards to them, but also introduced its history during the Republic of China. Then they went to the Old City God's Temple which is a shopping street with an ancient architectural style, and it is the best place to buy some unique souvenirs for their families and friends. In the evening, they visited the Jing'an district of Shanghai to watch the acrobatic performance of Yun Feng, the actors has been trained for a long time to perform such a wonderful performance, and it was an eye-opener for our students to appreciate the talent of these actors.

On the fourth day, they went to the China Art Palace, which is a museum of modern Chinese art located in Pudong, Shanghai. In addition, it was housed in the former China Pavilion of Expo 2010. The museum frequently hosts special themed exhibitions, mainly for the Chinese modern art. In this trip, they watched the animated version of Qing Ming Shang He Tu, which captured the daily life of people and the landscape



of the capital, Bian Jing during the Northern Song. It reveals the lifestyle of all levels of the society from the rich to the poor as well as different economic activities in rural areas and the city, it offers glimpses of period clothing and architecture as an artistic creation.

On the last day, they visited SAIC Volkswagen Automotive Company which is one of their favorite scenic spots. It is an automobile manufacturing company headquartered in Anting, China and a joint venture between Volkswagen Group and SAIC Motor. SAIC Volkswagen's Shanghai plant produces cars that can function as taxis, vehicles for government officials and transport for the newly emerging business elite. In this study tour, students were able to acquire more technological knowledge which can broaden their visions.

During this 5-day trip, they visited to lots of famous scenic spots, such as Shanghai Museum and Yu Garden. All of these were very amazing and impressive. They have learnt a lot in this technology study tour and experienced the latest technological development during these five days. It is definitely a fruitful memory to all teachers and students. There is a famous Chinese saying, 'Travelling thousands of miles is better than reading thousands of books'. It is so true that students can learn much more by being in other cities, seeing and experiencing by themselves. The Transition of Shanghai's Townscape

Shanghai is situated on the Chang Jiang Delta, with a population over 18 million. Shanghai serves as one of the most important multi-functional metropolitan cities in China, with a special historical background. Shanghai nowadays is a symbol of cultural integration. Walking along the "the Bund", we can see a range of buildings in European architectural style, like The Peace Hotel and The Shanghai Pudong Development Bank Co., Ltd.. They all acknowledged the long history of development in Shanghai.



On the other hand, Shanghai also has one of the world's busiest ports and it has become the largest cargo port in the world. After 1990s, Pudong New Area developed rapidly, which became the financial and commercial hub of eastern China. The Lujiazui Finance and Trade Zone and a skyline that includes the Oriental Pearl Tower and the Jin Mao Tower is a witness of the development of China's economy in the past decades.

Modernity mingled with classic elements have made Shanghai attractive to most visitors, including me. It is my first time to visit Shanghai, and I am impressed by the scenery around the vicinity of Nanjing Road. As Shanghai became a treaty port after the Opium wars, Nanjing Road was first under the British Concession, with its special status, it favored the importing of foreign goods. It became the earliest shopping street of the city. In the past decades, Nanjing Road was undergoing significant changes, and it is now a China's premier shopping street. Due to the market demand, modern shopping malls, department stores and prestigious historic hotels occurred on the two sides of the

road, mingled with the traditional stores and specialty shops, which formed a unique and charismatic landscape. This shows the transition of Shanghai townscape.
